



Woodcock Hill Primary School **Sports Premium Grant Summary** **Updated in Summer, 2019**

What is the Sports Premium Grant?

The Government introduced a Sports Premium Grant for schools in September 2013.

The Sports Premium Grant is designed to help primary schools improve the quality of the PE and sport activities they offer their pupils. The Government has invested over £450 million on this funding over the last 3 academic and coming academic year(s).

The objectives of the Sport Premium Grant funding are:

- To improve the quality of existing PE teaching
- To increase participation levels in competitive sport and healthy activity of pupils
- For schools to understand and value the benefit of high quality PE and sport
- To increase the quality of initial teacher training in PE and sport

Woodcock Hill Sports Premium Grant - Report for Governors

We have been allocated the following Sports Premium Grants over the last three years:

- 2019/20 = £ 8,000 (Estimated – Note that £3,609 has been notified to date)*
- 2018/19 = £ 17,776
- 2017/18 = £ 14,062

Developing Staff Skills and Expertise

We have used some of our Sports Premium Grant funding to offer After School Clubs (delivered by School Staff) and to team teach PE throughout the School. Teachers work take Pupils to Shenley Academy and work alongside their specialist Teachers and Coaches to develop their own skills and expertise as well as taking them to tournaments and events off site. This is allowing staff to become more skilled at delivering PE and sports.

For the last five years we have utilised the PE & Sports Grant to lease two minibuses. These will be returned in Summer, 2019 and a new strategy for spending this funding is being developed.

In the coming academic year (2019/20) we are looking at bringing in some expert Coaches to deliver sporting activities and PE lessons (alongside our own Staff), Lunchtime and After School clubs. It is hoped we will be able to demonstrate impact and will motivate the children as they compare their own scores term on term and see progress / success for themselves.

Swimming

The cost of transport to Swimming remains significant and has been supported by the Sports Premium Grant up until now.

Our Year 4, 5 & 6 Pupils go swimming in two week blocks in differentiated swimming groups. During the School year.

In the 2018/19 Academic year:

- 72% of Pupils in Year 6 could swim a range of strokes competently (for 10m+)
- 50% of Pupils in Year 6 could swim competently (for 25m+)
- 17% of Pupils in Year 6 could perform self rescue from the water

Sports Premium Spending Plan (Academic Year 2019/20) *

At the time of writing only the first tranche of Sports Premium Funding has been notified. We do however expect to fully achieve the £8,000 anticipated in the Budget Plan for 2019/20. How we intend to invest the Sports Premium Grant in 2019/20 is detailed below:
