My Maths is an interactive website that we will use to support maths. Pupils can access this to support all areas of the maths curriculum through set activities and games. Teachers will use this website to set weekly home learning tasks for your child to complete.

Times Tables Rockstars is an interactive and fun website designed to teach times tables. Pupils are encouraged to practise as often as possible and the website has a range of games and challenges to support all year groups. Teachers can monitor how well each pupil is doing and set challenges!
