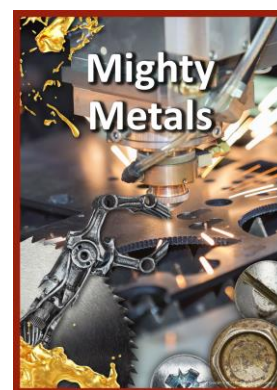
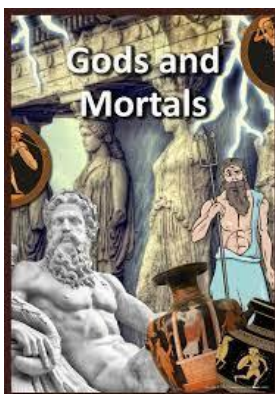


CURRICULUM INFORMATION



Year 3 – Autumn Term

Here is an overview of what your child will be learning this term which we hope you will find useful. We would welcome any comments or questions you might have.



English

Pupils will be studying a variety of Greek Myths including: Perseus the Gorgon Slayer, Orpheus and Eurydice and the feather-clad fliers Daedalus and Icarus. The Iron Giant by Ted Hughes will follow.

Pupils will be given the opportunity to compare a range of story settings, express their views about a story or poem and write non-chronological reports, explanations, instructions and recounts.

Please continue to help your child read by using their local library.

Maths

Pupils will continue to investigate place value and explore counting in hundreds.

Pupils will investigate a range of calculation strategies for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Improving mental maths skills will also be an important focus throughout the year.

Pupils should practise their times tables, particularly the 2x, 4x, 5x, 8x and 10x tables.

Arts 3-D sculpture, Greek art and design. Embossed patterns and making jewellery.

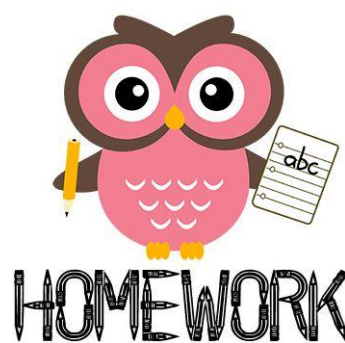
Playing the ukulele
