I already know:

Key Vocabulary:

human features	Things like houses, roads and bridges. People have built them.
physical features	Natural things like seas, mountains and rivers. They would be here even if there were no people around.
climate	weather conditions typical of a place over a period of time.
coastline	Where land meets water
island	a piece of land that is completely surrounded by water.
mainland	the largest part of a country when comparing it to islands around it.
aerial view	a photo taken from above to see the features of an area.
