Find out more about rock art – human-made markings placed on natural stone. Draw your own or a friend's pet in the style of a prehistoric cave painting.	Find a stone and paint it to look like an animal or decorate it with a pattern to make a paper-weight.	Draw fossils and label with information. 	Stone Age people could not pop to the shops for food. Everything they ate had to be caught or collected. Write your recipe for a Stone Age Dinner.	Make up your own story, it can be about anything you like but tell it through cave pictures.
