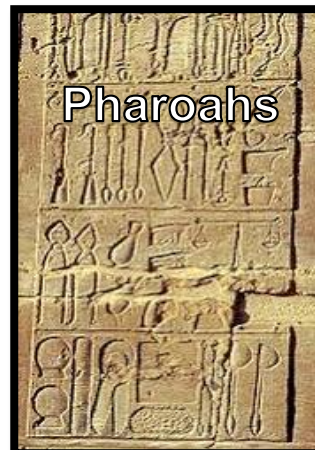
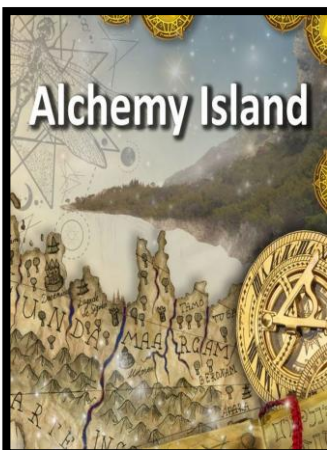


CURRICULUM INFORMATION



Year 5 - Autumn Term

Here is an overview of what your child will be learning this term which we hope you will find useful. We would welcome any comments or questions you might have.



English

Pupils will be reading Harry Potter and the Philosophers Stone by J K Rowling and Secrets of the Sun King by Emma Carroll. They will write fantasy narratives, non-chronological reports and poetry using cross curricular themes and knowledge.

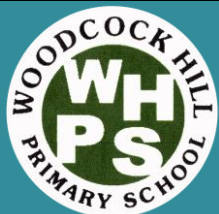
Pupils will recap on word classes, learn different sentence structures and clause structures. They will focus on the National Curriculum word list for Year 5, including Year 5 and 6 common exception words.

Please continue to help your child by using their local library.

Maths

The pupils will revise place value, concentrating on numbers up to 1 million, they will also practise rounding numbers within 1 million. They will deepen their understanding of the four main number operations and use them to solve real-life word problems.

Pupils will also study fractions and decimals, extending their knowledge to thousandths. They will also start learning about percentages. Pupils will also be drawing and interpreting graphs.



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Other Curriculum Areas

Science – Changing states, properties of materials, space and working scientifically.

Computing- Internet safety, virtual reality, design, debugging programs, gaming.

Humanities- Map reading, compass points, human and physical features.

P.E.- Benchball and hockey.

R.E.- Caring for ourselves, each other and the planet.

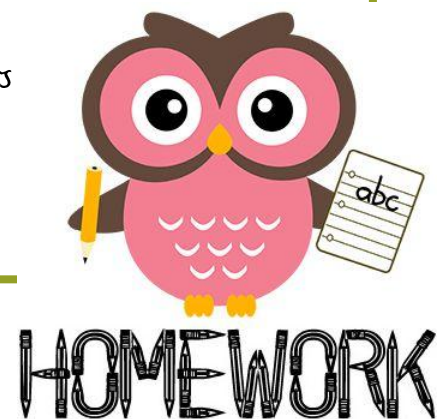
Arts- Landscapes, natural art, perspectives, creating and evaluating pieces.

Languages- French – introducing yourself and the date.

Pupils will also learn about relationships, health and a variety of social issues, including British Values through PSHE, citizenship, pastoral sessions and assemblies.

Things to do at home:

- Read every day and record it in your reading diary.
- Practise your spellings and times tables up to 12 x 12. There will be weekly tests!
- Complete your homework – use Times Tables Rockstars and Purplemash.
- Research your topics and learn your key vocabulary.
