

CURRICULUM INFORMATION



Year 5 - Spring Term

Here is an overview of what your child will be learning this term which we hope you will find useful. We would welcome any comments or questions you might have.



English

Pupils will be studying a variety of texts including: 'Charlotte's Web' by E. B. White and 'The Secret Garden' by Frances Hodgson Burnett. They will use these stories to develop their writing styles, including persuasive language and historical writings. Pupils will also read a variety of non-fiction texts.

The pupils will continue to develop their knowledge and understanding of English grammar, focusing on sentence structure and dialogue.

Maths

Pupils will explore written methods of multiplication and division, up to 4 digit by 1-digit numbers. They will also calculate division with remainders.

The focus will turn to adding and subtracting fractions and finding fractions of amounts. Pupils will also find decimals as fractions, they will order and compare decimals, calculate percentages and find equivalent fractions, decimals and percentages.

Pupils will be practising their times tables, up to 12 x 12.



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Other Curriculum Areas

Science – Living things and their Habitats, Animals including Humans.

Computing- Game design and word processing.

Humanities- Ancient Egypt, Mountains, land use in the United Kingdom including allotments, leisure through time.

P.E.- Gymnastics and tag rugby

R.E.- Being honest open and truthful, being modest and listening to others

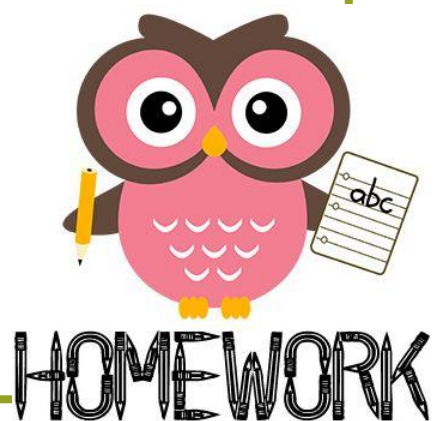
Design and technology – Bug hotels and growing our own food.
