Key Vocabulary:

agriculture	farming and the methods that are used to raise and look after crops and animals
allotment	a small piece of land used to grow fruit, vegetables and flowers
fair trade	a way of buying and selling produce to ensure farmers have good working conditions and get a fair price
arable	land used for the growing of crops
produce	foods such as fruit and vegetables that are grown or farmed
pastoral	land used for the keeping of animals e.g. grazing of sheep or cattle.
