Find out and write some facts about why animals were so important to the Egyptians.	Build a 3D model of a sarcophagus.	Draw, label and annotate an ancient Egyptian artefact.	Use your research skills to find out about a pharaoh of your choice.	Create a fact file about the River Nile and compare it to other famous world rivers. Include photographs and the range of amazing animals that live in and by the river
Write a diary entry for the water boy, who found the steps to Tutankhamun's tomb	Create a power point about your chosen Pharaoh.	Design 2-D or 3-D Egyptian-style jewellery. (You could use sketching pencils, clay, paints or crayons).	Find out what happened to Egypt after the death of Cleopatra VII, the last Pharaoh. Be prepared to give a short talk to the class about your findings!	Use the words ANCIENT EGYPT to create an acrostic poem
