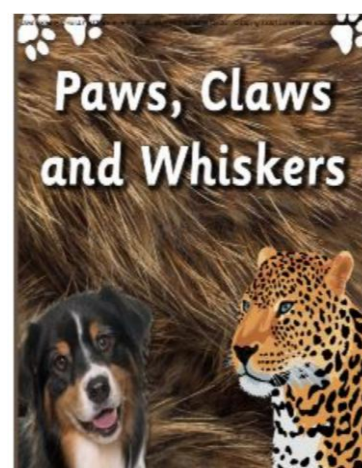
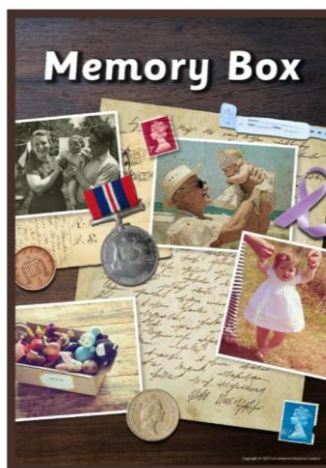


CURRICULUM INFORMATION



Year 1- Autumn Term

Here is an overview of what your child will be learning this term which we hope you will find useful. We would welcome any comments or questions you might have.



English

Pupils will be studying a variety of texts including: *Funnybones* and *Owl Babies*. Pupils will also read a variety of non-fiction texts.

They will continue to develop phonic knowledge through Read Write Inc lessons.

The pupils will develop their knowledge and understanding of English grammar, focusing on sentence structure, punctuation and speech.

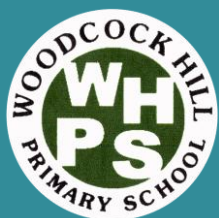
Please continue to help your child by using their local library.

Maths

The pupils will revise place value, develop their counting skills and identify one more or one less of a given number. They will learn to count in 2s, 5s and 10s.

Pupils will add and subtract numbers to 10 and solve one step problems involving addition and subtraction.

Pupils will represent and use number bonds within ten and explore the names and properties of 2D and 3D shapes.

Science - Exploring our senses and changes in our bodies and animals including humans.

Computing- Online Safety and Coding

Humanities- Investigating the weather, seasons, toys of the past and changes within living memories.

P.E.- Running, movement and dance.

Arts- Andrew Goldsworthy, Picasso, sculptures, animal masks and playing music.
