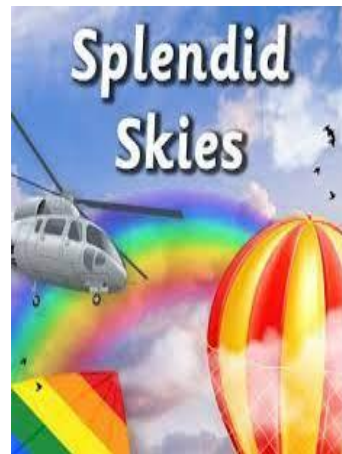
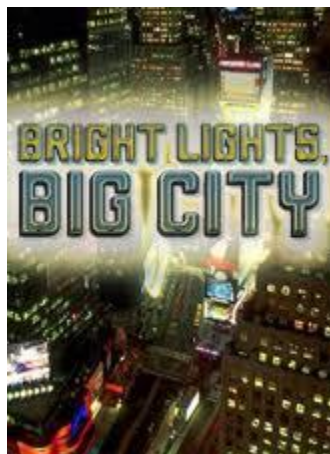


CURRICULUM INFORMATION



Year 1- Spring Term

Here is an overview of what your child will be learning this term which we hope you will find useful. We would welcome any comments or questions you might have.



English

Pupils will be studying a variety of texts including: Katie In London, Paddington Bear and The Bog Baby. Pupils will also read a variety of non-fiction texts.

They will continue to develop phonic knowledge through Read Write Inc lessons.

The pupils will continue to develop their knowledge and understanding of English grammar, focusing on sentence structure, punctuation and speech.

Please help your child by using their local library and sharing books at home.

Maths

Pupils will continue to develop their understanding of number through place value, ordering numbers and studying addition and subtraction up to 20 and counting up to 50.

Pupils will also recap and enhance their understanding of length, height, volume and weight.

Improving mental maths skills will be an important focus throughout the year.

Computing- Internet safety, pictograms, algorithms and virtual tours.

Geography –London and Weather in the World.

History - The Great Fire of London.

P.E.- Ball Skills and Gymnastics.

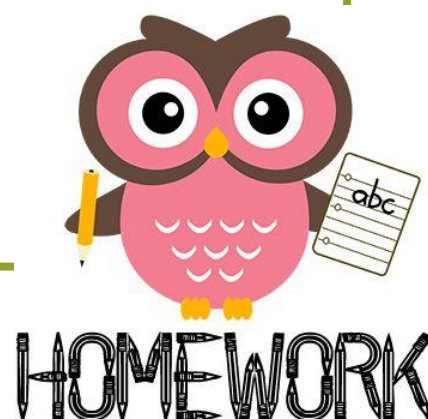
R.E.- Fairness, courage, and character.
