Key Vocabulary:

human features	Things like houses, roads and bridges. People have built them.
physical features	Natural things like seas, mountains and rivers. They would be here even if there were no people around.
village	A small place where people live, usually in the countryside.
town	A medium sized area where people live, with streets, houses and buildings.
city	A large place where many people live closely together.
map	2-D drawing of an area.
aerial view	a photo taken from above to see the features of an area.
near, far, left and right	locational directions to describe where something is.
