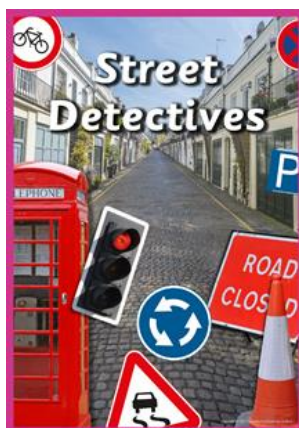


CURRICULUM INFORMATION



Year 2- Autumn Term

Here is an overview of what your child will be learning this term which we hope you will find useful. We would welcome any comments or questions you might have.



English

Pupils will read a variety of texts including *Last Stop on Market Street* by Matt De La Pene and *In the City* by Holly James.

Pupils will write recounts, captions, rhymes, instructions, adverts and stories.

Pupils will use capital letters, full stops, finger spaces and commas in their writing consistently.

Pupils will be given the opportunity to develop their reading through reading independently, using the school library and listening to stories to develop an enthusiasm for books.

Maths

Pupils will continue to use place value, comparing and ordering numbers to 100 and reading and writing numerals in words when solving problems.

Pupils will also focus on addition, subtraction, multiplication, division and word problems.

Pupils will also investigate solving problems involving money, time, interpreting data and identifying and describing 2D and 3D shapes.

Pupils will be learning 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables.



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Other Curriculum Areas

Science- Materials and their properties, Plants and Sound.

Computing- Online Safety and Coding

Humanities- The School grounds and the local area, using maps, musical eras and composers, genres of music.

P.E.- Gymnastics and Dance.

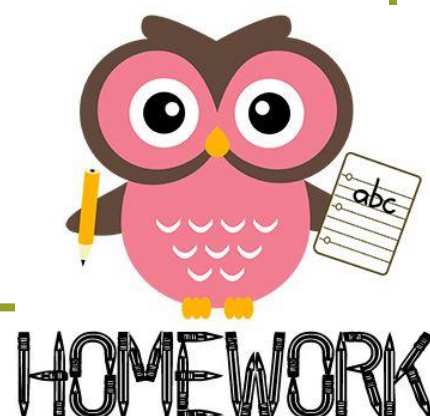
R.E.- Belonging to a community, living by rules, influences on behaviour, being considerate to others.

Pupils will also learn about relationships, health and a variety of social issues, including British Values through PSHE, citizenship, pastoral sessions and assemblies.
