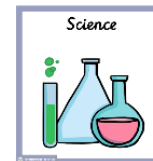


Science Knowledge Organiser

Key Vocabulary:

float	to stay on the surface of a liquid
sink	to fall below the surface of a liquid
vessel	a ship or boat
waterproof	something that keeps liquid out or stops it from going through
absorbent	something that soaks up liquid
