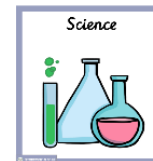

Key Vocabulary:

invertebrate	an animal that doesn't have a backbone or spine in its body
habitat	the natural environment where a plant or animal lives
food chain	shows how energy moves from one living thing to another, starting with plants and ending with animals
insect	a small animal with six legs, a body divided into 3 parts and usually two pairs of wings
living	something that is alive and needs food water and can grow and reproduce
