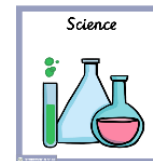

Key Vocabulary:

predator	an animal that hunts, kills, and eats other animals
prey	an animal that is hunted and killed by another animal for food
food chain	a series of living things that eat each other, showing how energy and nutrients pass from one organism to the next
habitat	the place where an animal or plant lives, providing everything it needs to survive
producer	an organism that makes its own food, rather than getting energy by eating other organisms
consumer	an organism that eats another organism for energy
