Use an online translation tool to write well-known phrases in Latin, the language of the Romans. Perhaps you could write a birthday or seasonal greeting?	Make a model of a Roman villa using junk materials such as cereal boxes, coloured paper, tin foil and cardboard tubes. 	Make a drawing of a Roman god or goddess. Write a fact file of information.	Find out the dates of birth of your family and friends and record them in Roman numerals. 
Investigate different states of matter. Look around your house and make a list of different solids, liquids and gases that you can find. Are there any items that change between states?	Research a tourist attraction in Italy. Describe it, draw it (or use pictures you have found), and explain why it is a tourist attraction.	Research a historical figure, or famous person from Italy. 	Design an outfit for a Roman Emperor or wealthy Roman individual.	Design a Roman feast. Make sure you include dishes that the Romans would have enjoyed.
