Our topic this half term is Traders and Raiders. We will be studying: Food chains, Myths and Legends, Vikings, their art and jewellery, and exploring trade.

Find out about and produce a poster on the Staffordshire Hoard, the largest Anglo-Saxon gold hoard ever found. It is currently on display in the Potteries Museum in Stoke-on-Trent.	Research and produce a fact file about a significant person, e.g. St. Bede, Alfred the Great, Hengist & Horsa, Eric Bloodaxe, Edward the Confessor, Harold Godwinson, William of Normandy.	Write a short message using the Futhark alphabet, using letters or 'runes' as they were known. 	Draw, paint or create a poster or fact-file about a Viking God or Goddess.	Draw or make a map of Britain or Europe. Show where the Saxons and Vikings came from and/or how the country was divided between them.
Produce a model of an Anglo-Saxon, or Viking, village or dwelling. 	Anglo Saxons and Vikings were fierce warriors. Research and make a weapon that they typically used in battle.	Look at images of Anglo Saxon coins and design or make your own.	The shield was considered the most important piece of military equipment by Anglo Saxons. Design your own.	Design an outfit for an Anglo-Saxon or a Viking. Think about what they would wear in their everyday life.
