Vocabulary

leaves	One of the usually green flat parts of a plant that grows from the stem or branch.
Autumn	One of the four seasons.
hibernation	When an animal goes into deep sleep until Spring.
conker	A seed from a horse chestnut tree.
acorn	A seed from an oak tree.
fir Cone	The fruit of a pine tree.

Sticky Knowledge

Autumn	Autumn is the season after Summer and before Winter. It is a time of change. Leaves change colour and fall from the trees. Animals prepare for the Winter. The weather changes and becomes colder.
Harvest	Harvest means to collect what has been planted. It is usually done in the Autumn.
The Little Red Hen	The Little Red Hen is a fable set in the Autumn about a hen who shows us the value of hard work.
Season	The year is split into four seasons. Spring, Summer, Autumn and Winter.
