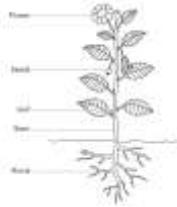


# CURRICULUM INFORMATION



## Reception- Summer

Here is an overview of what your child will be learning this term which we hope you will find useful. We would welcome any comments or questions you might have.



### Growing and Summer



#### Literacy

Pupils will be looking at and reading story books and non-fiction books about plants, flowers and Summer. They will be learning and practising their sounds in phonics. They will be reading and writing words, captions and writing short sentences. They will be reading, sequencing and writing about to plant a seed and making a fact file.

#### Maths

Pupils will be recognising numbers to 20 and comparing sets of objects. They will be adding two sets of objects together and taking some objects away. They will be counting on and back, practising doubling and halving, sharing numbers of objects and know what numbers are odd and even. They will be comparing shapes, measuring volume and exploring time.

#### Understanding the World

Pupils will be looking at life cycles and what plants need to grow. They will be exploring how summer is different to the other seasons and what different habitats are like.

#### Communication and Language

Pupils will be learning about and naming plants and flowers. They will sequence planting a seed. They will talk about Summer and activities that they do. They will talk about the history of the seaside.



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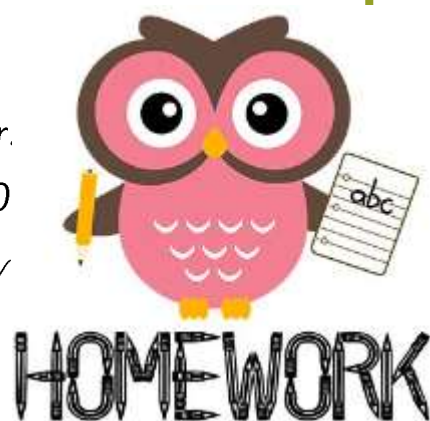
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<i>Personal, Social and Emotional Development</i>	<i>Expressive Art and Design</i>
<p>Pupils will be able to talk about the different factors that support their overall health and wellbeing – hygiene, healthy food, tooth brushing, regular physical activity and being a safe pedestrian.</p> <p>They will be able to build good relationships and value themselves as individuals.</p>	<p>Pupils will be making flowers, junk model mini-beasts and Punch and Judy puppets using a variety of materials. <p>Pupils will be strengthening their hands and arms with daily play dough disco and Squiggle sessions. They will practice their fine motor skills by cutting, drawing, squeezing and dotting. They will have a weekly P.E session with the sports coach.</p>	<p>Pupils will be using Purple Mash to enhance their learning.</p>
<p>Pupils will also learn about relationships, health and a variety of social issues, including British Values through PSHE, citizenship, pastoral sessions and assemblies.</p>

- Practise writing your lower case and capital letters and numbers
- Complete your weekly homework
