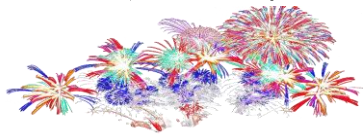


Get Creative
Make a firework picture.

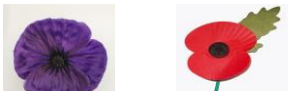


You could use paint, pencils, pastels
