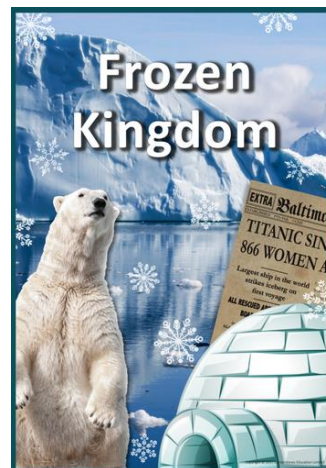
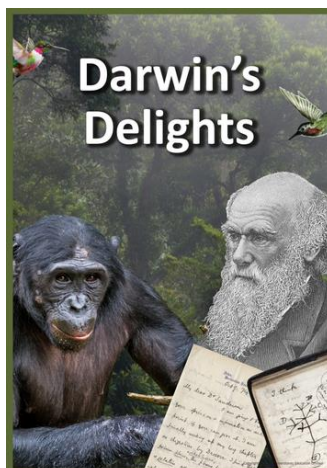


CURRICULUM INFORMATION



Year 6- Autumn Term

Here is an overview of what your child will be learning this term which we hope you will find useful. We would welcome any comments or questions you might have.



English

Pupils will be reading Skellig by David Almond and The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe by CS Lewis. They will write diary entries, biographies, fantasy narratives, balanced arguments and Haiku poetry using cross curricular themes and knowledge.

Pupils will recap the main punctuation marks needed in their writing, including semi colons, dashes and hyphens. Pupils will also start learning Year 6 grammar.

Please continue to help your child by using their local library.

Maths

Pupils will revise place value, concentrating on numbers up to 10 million. They will also consolidate their understanding of the four main number operations and use them to solve frequency and reasoning problems.

Pupils will also study fractions. They will be able to multiply and divide fractions and use percentages and decimals to convert.

Pupils will revisit position and direction including using four quadrants of a coordinates grid.



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Other Curriculum Areas

Science- Living Things and Their Habitats, Evolution and Inheritance.

Computing- Online Safety and Coding

Humanities- Charles Darwin, The Galapagos Islands, Geography of the Polar regions and Polar Exploration.

P.E.- Gymnastics, Basketball and Football.

R.E.- Fair and Just, Living by Rules, Inclusion and Unity and Harmony.

Arts- Sketching flora and shells and The Northern Lights.

Languages- Regular French Verbs and School Vocabulary.

Pupils will also learn about relationships, health and a variety of social issues, including British Values through PSHE, citizenship, pastoral sessions and assemblies.

Things to do at home:

- Practise your spellings- tests will be on a Friday!
- Practise your times tables.
- Research your topics and learn your key vocabulary.
