Key Vocabulary:

Allied Powers	countries who fought the Axis Powers (Britain, France, the Soviet Union and USA)
Axis Powers	countries who fought the Allied Powers (Germany, Italy and Japan)
concentration camp	a place where large numbers of people, especially Jews, were held and often killed
evacuee	a person sent away from a city to live in the countryside, which was considered safer
Holocaust	the mass murder of Jews
Nazi	a follower of the political party controlled by Adolf Hitler.
persecute	to treat someone cruelly or unfairly
propaganda	biased news, media and communication used to influence peoples opinions.
rationing	limiting supplies of food, clothes and other goods to prevent shortages
