

Religious Education

What is it that people live by and live for? What is it that makes people happy? In RE the deepest values of human life are shared and discussed.

We develop pupil's tolerance towards others through knowledge and understanding of religious beliefs, practices, languages and traditions as individuals in a multi-cultural community. Our children have the opportunity to explore and respond to a range of fundamental questions relating to their own spiritual development.
