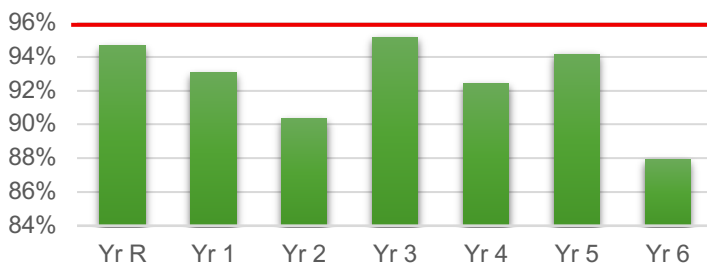

Applications opened on 1st September 2025 for secondary school places for entry in September 2026. **The closing date is 31st October 2025 at 11:59pm.**

It is important that you apply on time. If you apply late, you are less likely to get offered a place at any of your preferred schools.

Applications received after the 31st October 2025 will be classed as late applications and will not be processed until after the offer of places on 2nd March 2026.
