We have reached the end of the Spring Term; this means warm summer days, light nights, BBQs and family day trips lie ahead of us.

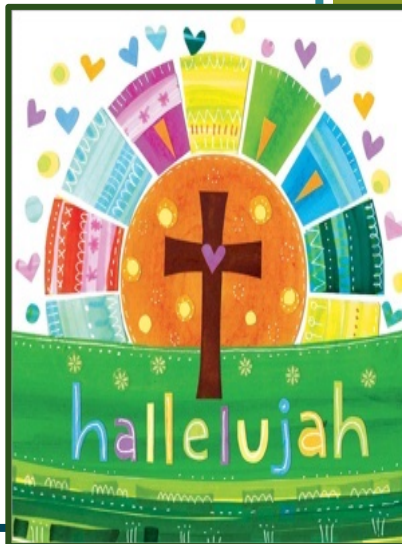

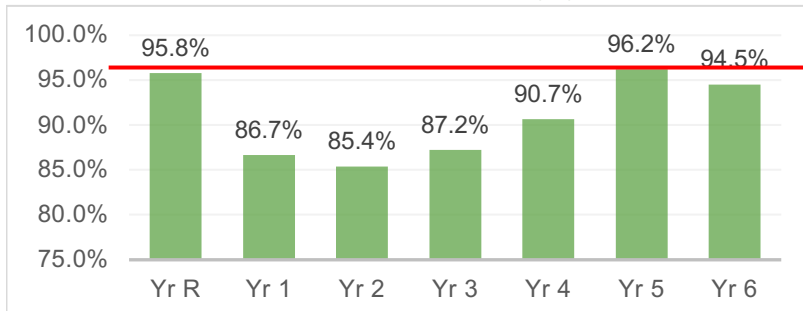

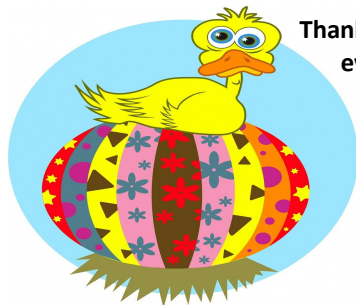
