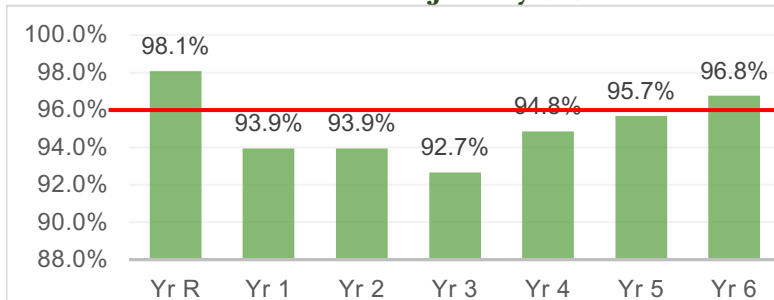

## Attendance

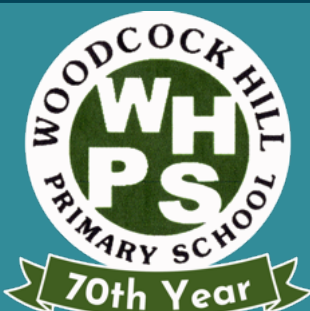

## Changes to School Lunches

On Monday 20<sup>th</sup> January, we introduced a new way that pupils order their lunch at school. Children are asked, during registration, if they would like the following for lunch on that day:

- **Hot** – a choice of a hot meal; options will change weekly, this will be indicated at the top of the 'diary section' of the school's newsletter (full menus are on our notice board and school website).
- **Cold** – there will be an assortment of sandwiches and wraps available every day for children that would prefer this option; fillings will include cheese, ham, tuna and jam (sandwiches only).
- **Jacket Potatoes** – these will be available daily, with an assortment of fillings, including cheese, beans, and tuna. There will also be the additional option of chili con carne and curry on certain days.

**All the above options are accompanied by a 'Deli' bar which includes a selection of fresh salad and vegetables.**

- **Packed Lunch** – Children may still bring in their own healthy packed lunch from home.

We ask that you please discuss these options with your child and explain to them that they will be asked each day for their lunch option. As this food will be made to order, once your child has selected what they would like, **they will NOT be able to change their mind once they are at the meals' counter.**
